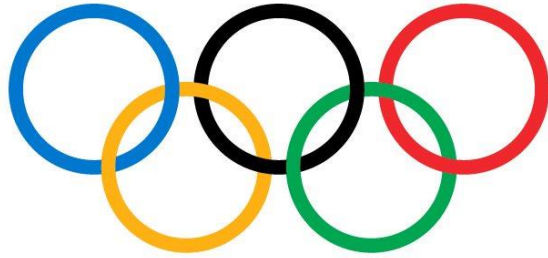

- **OVEP combines teaching methodologies, tools, and activities that facilitate the promotion and implementation of civic values through sport.**
Through OVEP, sport serves as a platform for values-based learning, enabling students to develop 21st century skills and put Olympic values into action both inside and outside the classroom.
- **A thorough analysis of the programme was conducted in 2021-2022**, focusing on developing a comprehensive education strategy through strengthening partnerships, leveraging digital transformation, and enhancing existing content.
- Through 2021 to 2024, the programme has seen significant developments, including **expansion of activities in key regions, capacity building, educational resources updates, and new partnerships.**

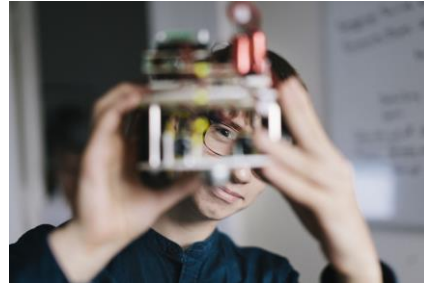
Competency-based Education

- Enhance **inter-cultural knowledge transfer** by sharing best practices and resources across borders
- Use sport, its values and its messages to prevent youth violence and **promote positive youth development** and behaviors
- Provides a **platform that can foster community involvement** through service learning and projects
- Uses every opportunity to teach about **topics such as climate change, human rights and social justice**
- Uses **innovative teaching methods** to expand the reach of the programme, one of the notable examples is **arts integration approach** it has been promoting, linking OVEP to Olympian Artists programme
